Bin Collection Information



- Bins must be placed 1 metre from the kerb and with a minimum of 0.5-1 metre clear space on either side, away from letter boxes, posts, vehicles and branches prior to 6am
- Place all rubbish inside the bin - rubbish not placed in the bin won't be collected
- Only council approved bins will be collected
- Bin wheels should be facing your property
- Contents <70kg- do not overload your bin
- Overfilling or compacting your bin with cardboard or lawn clippings that are not bagged, and jamming the waste will prevent its contents being emptied

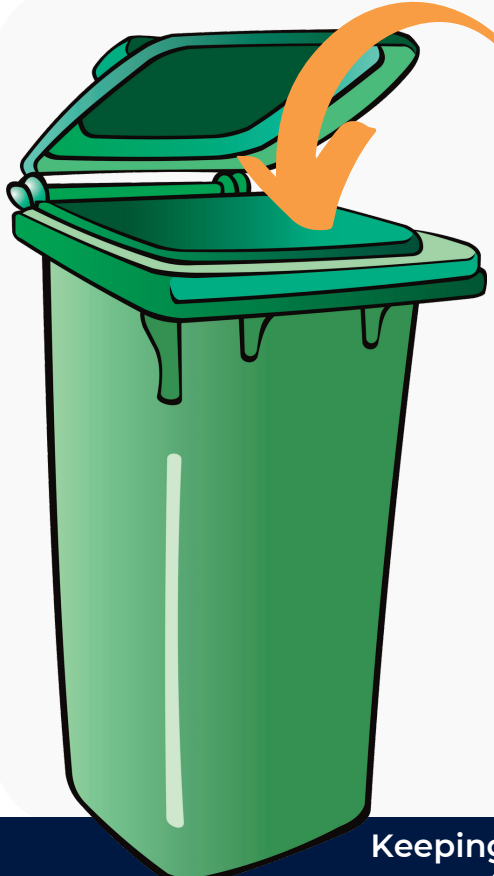
What to put in your bin
